Matthew 22:36-40

36 "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" 37 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

1. You can't give something you don't have
 - True joy and permanent peace comes from knowing Jesus, not the things we acquire
 - Christianity is not the work we do but the relationship we maintain and the atmosphere that is produced by that relationship
 - If your relationship with God does not lead to loving people, you should question your OBEDIENCE to God
2. Helping people is life's best investment because God is the rewarder
 - What you have is enough for someone to get out of their desperation situation
 - Come to a place where God can't afford to lose you
