So David would not move the ark of the LORD with him into the City of David; but David took it aside into the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite. The ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite three months. And the LORD blessed Obed-Edom and all his household. Now it was told King David, saying, "The LORD has blessed the house of Obed-Edom and all that belongs to him, because of the ark of God." 2 Samuel 6:10-12 (NKJV)

1. WHATEVER THE HOLY SPIRIT BREAKS, YOU ARE EMPOWERED TO REMOVE!

Then the Philistines took the ark of God and brought it from Ebenezer to Ashdod. When the Philistines took the ark of God, they brought it into the house of Dagon and set it by Dagon. And when the people of Ashdod arose early in the morning, there was Dagon, fallen on its face to the earth before the ark of the LORD. So they took Dagon and set it in its place again. And when they arose early the next morning, there was Dagon, fallen on its face to the ground before the ark of the LORD. The head of Dagon and both the palms of its hands were broken off on the threshold; only Dagon's torso was left of it. 1 Samuel 5:1-4 (NKJV)

The Presence of God can't be controlled.

The Presence of God wouldn't cohabitate with other gods.

The Presence of God conquers other gods.

He stirs up the sea with His power, and by His understanding, He breaks up the storm. By His Spirit He adorned the heavens; His hand pierced the fleeing serpent. Job 26:12-13 (NKJV)

2. THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL MAKE NO DIFFERENCE IN SOMEONE WHO IS INDIFFERENT TO HIM!

Then the men of Kirjath Jearim came and took the ark of the LORD, and brought it into the house of Abinadab on the hill, and consecrated Eleazar his son to keep the ark of the LORD. So it was that the ark remained in Kirjath Jearim a long time; it was there twenty years. And all the house of Israel lamented after the LORD. 1 Samuel 7:1-2 (NKJV)

So they set the ark of God on a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill; and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drove the new cart. 2 Samuel 6:3 (NKJV)

And when they came to Nachon's threshing floor, Uzzah put out his hand to the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen stumbled. Then the anger of the LORD was aroused against Uzzah, and God struck him there for his error; and he died there by the ark of God. 2 Samuel 6:6-7 (NKJV)





Indifference to the Holy Spirit will lead to irreverence of the Holy Spirit.

Proximity to the Holy Spirit doesn't matter as much as a passion for the Holy Spirit.

3. THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL TRANSFORM THOSE WHO TAKE HIM IN.

The Blessing:

- Visible
- Immediate
- Because of the Presence
- Others wanted the ark, not the blessing
- Produced ministry, not materialism

Obed-Edom was a gatekeeper 1 Chronicles 15:18

Obed-Edom was a musician 1 Chronicles 16:5

Obed-Edom was a doorkeeper for the ark 1 Chronicles 15:24

Obed-Edom was a watchman for South Gate 1 Chronicles 26:15

Obed-Edom's 8 sons were leaders and were over the storehouse 1 Chronicles 26:15, 4-8

Uzzah was a levite, Obed-Edom was a Gittite. (Philistine)

Don't stay where the blessing is, follow where the Blesser (The Holy Spirit) is going.

When you are attracted by the Blesser (The Holy Spirit), you will not be distracted by the blessing.
