



Ministry to the masses (miracles) and multiplying yourself in the few people (discipleship).

Matthew 9:35–37

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.

If you have miracles - you will have a crowd.

If you have disciples - you have a future.

You are mistaken not knowing the power of God.

Matthew 22:29 (NKJV)

Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God.

You are not maturing if you don't multiply.

Exodus 1:10 (NKJV)

Come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and it happen, in the event of war, that they also join our enemies and fight against us, and so go up out of the land."

The devil will throw everything at you so that you don't multiply so that he can steal the future.

Preservation protects my comfortable life but it also prevents future Moses from being born.

Discipleship without deliverance ends in defeat.

John 11:44 (NKJV)

And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with grave clothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."

Deliverance without discipleship ends in disobedience.

Matthew 21:2

Saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Loose them and bring them to Me.



You can't get disciplined if you are not delivered but you can get delivered and never go into discipleship.

- Deliverance is what God does for you, discipleship is what God does in you.
- Deliverance without discipleship is a big chest, small legs.
- Deliverance without discipleship is like getting out of Egypt and never entering the promised land but getting stuck in wilderness.

John 14:15 (NKJV)

Mark 16:15
