



Wild Anointing

1. God doesn't use us - He anoints us.

Then he arose and went into the house. And he poured the oil on his head, and said to him, "Thus says the Lord God of Israel: 'I have anointed you king over the people of the Lord, over Israel.'" 2 Kings 9:6 (NKJV)

The anointing is more important than a position and a title!

2. The anointing causes people to turn around and follow God.

"So the horseman went to meet him, and said, 'Thus says the king: Is it peace?' And Jehu said, 'What have you to do with peace? Turn around and follow me.'" So the watchman reported, saying, 'The messenger went to them, but is not coming back.'" 2 Kings 9:18 (NKJV)

Conversion is more than a confession; it's repentance of sin.

"And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God." Luke 1:16 (NKJV)

He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord." Luke 1:17 (NKJV)

- Turn people to God
- Turn fathers to the children
- Turn disobedient to wisdom

3. The anointing confronts the demonic, it doesn't conform to it.

"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him." Acts 10:38 (NKJV)

4. Jezebel will try to put a hook (intimidation) into you but when it fails, she will put on lipstick (attraction).

"Now when Jehu had come to Jezreel, Jezebel heard of it; and she put paint on her eyes and adorned her head, and looked through a window." 2 Kings 9:30 (NKJV)

5. Jezebel couldn't stop Jehu, Jehu stopped Jehu.



"But Jehu was not careful to walk in the law of the LORD, the God of Israel, with all his heart. He did not turn from the sins of Jeroboam, which he made Israel to sin." 2 Kings 10:31

"Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood." Acts 20:28
