God gives promise of prosperity.

Let them shout for joy and be glad, who favor my righteous cause; and let them say continually, "Let the LORD be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant." Psalm 35:27

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. 3 John 1:2

God gives power to prosperity.

"And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 8:18

God gives principles of prosperity.

He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper. Psalm 1:3

God's principles develop our patience.

A faithful man will abound with blessings, but he who hastens to be rich will not go unpunished. Proverbs 28:20

An inheritance gained hastily at the beginning will not be blessed at the end. Proverbs 20:21

1. Don't seek MONEY, seek to do well.

And I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants." ' Luke 15:19

Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. 1 Timothy 4:15

And his master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD made all he did to prosper in his hand. Genesis 39:3

Money is not the root of all evil, it's a medium of exchange for goods or services.

2. Instead of CHASING money, seek after God!

And not many days after, the younger son gathered all together, journeyed to a far country, and there wasted his possessions with prodigal living. Luke 15:13

He sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God; and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him prosper. 2 Chronicles 26:5

3. Instead of CHASING money, pursue integrity.

Poverty comes as a result of an attack of Satan, affliction of life, an act of love, and aftermath of sin.

For the drunkard and the glutton will come to poverty, and drowsiness will clothe a man with rags. Proverbs 23:21





Do not love sleep, lest you come to poverty; open your eyes, and you will be satisfied with bread. Proverbs 20:13

He who tills his land will have plenty of bread, but he who follows frivolity will have poverty enough! Proverbs 28:19

For by means of a harlot a man is reduced to a crust of bread; and an adulteress will prey upon his precious life. Proverbs 6:26

He who loves pleasure will be a poor man; he who loves wine and oil will not be rich. Proverbs 21:17

The soul of a lazy man desires, and has nothing; but the soul of the diligent shall be made rich. Proverbs 13:4

Poverty and shame will come to him who disdains correction, but he who regards a rebuke will be honored. Proverbs 13:18

A man with an evil eye hastens after riches, and does not consider that poverty will come upon him. Proverbs 28:22
