### 1. We should surrender to the Holy Spirit instead of surrendering to our situation.

Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, 1 Peter 5:6

Faith rests on God's past faithfulness, His presence, and promises.

## 2. On the day of trial, don't test the Lord or try Him; trust the Holy Spirit.

"Trust is passive. Faith is active" Pastor Haw and Lia (Generations)
Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; Proverbs 3:8
We have greater reasons not to be afraid.

## 3. The Holy Spirit will develop us if we replace complaining with communion with Him.

Complaining contaminates faith.

Complaining to the devil is what worship is to God!

Israel extended their wilderness by complaining. Jesus overcame His wilderness by confessing God's word.

Do all things without complaining and disputing, Philippians 2:14

#### 4. The Holy Spirit wants to develop sensitivity to Him when our sight fails.

When you can't see, develop your hearing.

And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Mark 10:47

Then He said to them, "Take heed what you hear. With the same measure you use, it will be measured to you; and to you who hear, more will be given. Mark 4:24
