

Tactic #1. One team one fight.

- Your enemy's mission: To steal, kill, and destroy your life.
- As a member of the Lords Army, we all have a role to play.

1 Corinthians 12:12,14,25-27 ESV

12 For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. 14 For the body does not consist of one member but of many. 25 that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. 26 If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together. 27 Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.

- "As I say there is a saying that goes like this"
- Some roles may be less desirable than others, but it doesn't make them any less important.
- We are all enlisted and serving the kingdom, but do you know what your role is as a member of the Lords Army?

Tactic #2 It takes two.

- You can't do life alone.
- There's no way you can enter a room alone safely.
- Just like you can't clear a room alone, you can't go into your next season alone.
- If you want to go fast, go alone, if you want to go far go together.
- The distance you go is determined by the community you surround yourself with.
- Yesterday's successes and security doesn't guarantee today's protection. Complacency kills.
- A team needs to be healthy at the individual level or it will be spread too thin and eventually break.
- Pride will tell you that you can enter that room alone...don't be the prideful lone wolf.

James 4: 6-8 ESV God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you

- When you're living in pride, God resists you but there is a grace on the humble.
- The lone wolf is isolated.
- Solitude doesn't mean you're a lone wolf. Invite brothers/sisters. Draw from the community.





- Many of the most intense battles are fought behind closed doors.
- If you Lack fulfillment and are questioning your place...return to His presence.
- "Your place is not in your title. Your place is the secret place."
- Are you part of the wolfpack or are you a lone wolf?

Tactic #3. Give no place to division or offense.

- Other assignments will be done differently than yours...it doesn't mean one way is wrong
- God created you for a purpose. Don't try to do someone else's assignment that you were not called to.
- Some things don't really matter and they're not worth the division of the body.
- Are you edifying the body of Christ or are you shooting each other?
- "We are not the body of HungryGen, Bethel, First Baptist but the Body of Christ."

Ecclesiastes 4:12 ESV

12 And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him—a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

- If you're in a season of following, be the best follower.
- Be faithful in the small things so you can be entrusted with much.
- This community is your base. It's where you are stationed. Where He equips and strengthens each individual to be sent out.
- Are we being used as effectively as God is giving us the opportunity to?
- Many of us are on fire but are we burning together?
