Seven Practical Steps on Discerning if They Are The One:

1. Predecide to Choose from Your Spiritual Family.

And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven and the God of the earth, that you will not take a wife for my son from the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell; but **you shall go to my country** and **to my family**, and take a wife for my son Isaac." Genesis 24:3-4

This is what the LORD commands concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, 'Let them marry whom they think best, but they may marry only within the family of their father's tribe.' Numbers 36:6

A wife is bound by law as long as her husband lives; but if her husband dies, **she is at liberty to be** married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 7:39

2. While Waiting, Seek the Well - Not the Spiritual Wilderness!

The LORD God of heaven, who took me from my father's house and from the land of my family, and who spoke to me and swore to me, saying, To your descendants I give this land,' He will send His angel before you, and you shall take a wife for my son from there. Genesis 24:7

God's providence occurs at God's place.

Don't waste your waiting period by going to clubs; go to the well instead.

Rebekah and Isaac (Gen 24): Abraham's servant met Rebekah at a well.

Rachel and Jacob (Gen 29): Jacob met Rachel at a well.

Moses and Zipporah (Ex 2): They met at a well.

3. Pray About Your Prospects While You're in the Process of Waiting!

Then he said, "O LORD God of my master Abraham, please give me success this day, and show kindness to my master Abraham. Genesis 24:12

Desperation clouds your **discernment**, making you unable to see the difference between **Satan's** bait and God's blessing.

When you're impatient and lonely, you **tend** to make impulsive decisions that result in the **birthing** of Ishmael instead of waiting for God to bring about Isaac.

If you don't wait on God to bring the right person, you **might** end up **waiting** on God to fix the wrong person.

God is writing your love story; don't steal His pen.

4. Please Pay Attention to the Signs.

Now let it be that the young woman to whom I say, 'Please let down your pitcher that I may drink,' and she says, 'Drink, and I will also give your camels a drink'—let her be the one You have appointed for Your servant Isaac. And by this I will know that You have shown kindness to my master." Genesis 24:14

Be aware of the important signs:

- How do they treat others, especially their family and friends?
- How do they behave in different settings—public and private?
- What kind of content do they consume on social media?
- Who influences them?
- Do you agree with them doctrinally?
- Are their friends mature and respectable?





- Do your close friends and family approve of them?
- Do you have peace about them?
- Can you trust them?

5. Stay Pure in the Dating Process.

And the man, wondering at her, remained silent so as to know whether the LORD had made his journey prosperous or not. Genesis 24:12
