

# History



Hungry Generation was birthed from a vision in the heart of Pastor Vasiliy to help people who: don't know God, have had a church experience void of a connection with God, and for those in need of freedom and healing from their past. The church was founded in 2001, shortly after Pastor Vasiliy immigrated from Ukraine to Tri-Cities, WA. In August of 2003, we purchased the property in Pasco, which became our home base.

From the beginning, Pastor Vasiliy has had the vision to raise the younger generation. He poured into teenagers to become ministers at a very young age. Vlad became a youth leader at the age of 16, and for 14 years, that youth group became the church that we see today. In 2016 at the age of 30, Pastor Vlad became the lead pastor of HungryGen alongside our dynamic pastors and leaders.

# Deliverance is Essential

There are 33 recorded miracles of Jesus. Sixteen healings and seven deliverances from demons. Deliverance is children's bread (Matthew 15:26).

Christians can have demons, but demons can't have Christians. Demons can't own believers, but they can bind them. The Bible warns believers not to give a place to the devil (Ephesians 4:27). Demons can enter through many different doors, but they leave only when cast out in Jesus' name. We can't counsel demons out; they must be cast out!

Deliverance from demons is Jesus' ministry (Acts 10:38). Ministry of deliverance is called a miracle (Mark 9:39).

We offer deliverance once a month in our prayer line and once a month via online. We pray for deliverance in our small groups.

# Raising the Next Generation

"When that generation had all been gathered to their fathers, another generation arose after them who did not know the LORD nor the work which He had done for Israel."

(Judges 2:10)

Since its inception, HungryGen has invested strategically in kids, youth, and young adults.

We want to avoid a situation like the one described in Judges 2:10: "...another generation arose after them who did not know the LORD nor the work which He had done for Israel."

The devil is targeting children. The woke agenda aims to influence our kids through the school curriculum, and media promoting LGBT agenda to the younger generation.

We strongly believe that it's not the government's job to raise our kids; it's our responsibility and privilege to raise them as disciples of Jesus.



# Radical Generosity

- Tithing means 10. This 4000-year ritual traces back to Abraham. We don't have to tithe; we get to tithe. It's not an obligation but an opportunity to put God first in our finances. We believe that God can do more with our 90% than we can do with our 100%.
- We have seen again and again that we can't outgive God.
   When we start tithing, our financial problems become
   God's. Tithing keeps money from becoming our master.
- On top of tithing, we practice radical generosity that we call financial sacrifice. Our generation lives beyond their means, but we want to teach our church to give beyond our means. We believe that radical generosity marks our spiritual, eternal, and financial life.






## **Honor Code**

Exemplifying the highest moral commitment, HungryGen Church maintains a disciplined life of Bible reading, prayer, and fasting. You must also refrain from such things as:

## **Leadership Structure**

**We are Overseen** by the Founding Pastor, Vasiliy Parkhotyuk. Our founding pastor is under the Superintendent of National Slavic District of USA (Currently, Viktor Prokhor ( www.nsd.church )

We are Guided by the Senior Pastors, Pastors Vlad and Lana Savchuk. The senior pastors oversee the spiritual health of the church, ensure overall commitment to the mission, and provide direction for the vision. They serve the congregation by equipping and empowering staff, tribe leaders, and life group leaders.

We are Protected by the Board of Trustees. This board consists of seven congregation members voted in through a majority vote by the trustees of the board to oversee the finances and direct the provision of the facilities needed by the church. They provide counsel, and checks and balances to the senior pastor regarding the significant financial commitments of the church.

**We are Strengthened** by the staff. The staff of HungryGen is a vital part of the church structure and government. They bring ideas, develop, oversee and implement the day-to-day operations.

### Abuse Policy Acknowledgment

I understand that HungryGen Church is a safe place for children and vulnerable adults and that HungryGen Church complies with all Federal and State laws regarding reporting suspected child abuse. As a member of the Dream Team, I understand that suspected abuse is to be reported to the staff member who oversees the area in which I serve. I also understand the four types of abuse defined below:

- **Physical**: a physical act directed at a vulnerable child or an adult that causes injury.
- **Sexual**: contact or interactions between a child and an adult, or another child, when the child is being used for sexual stimulation of the perpetrator or another person. This includes exploitation through photographs, videos, or other communication methods.

- **Emotional**: acts or omissions by the parent or other caregivers that have caused or could cause severe behavioral, cognitive, emotional, or mental disorders.
- **Neglect**: failure to provide for the child or vulnerable adult's basic needs. This includes adequate adult supervision, medical attention, housing, food, and clothing. Most cases of physical neglect involve inadequate adult supervision that has caused harm to the child or vulnerable adult or places them in danger.

**Acknowledgment**: I understand it is not my responsibility to investigate, and in no instance will I confront a parent or caregiver if abuse is suspected. As a member of the HungryGen Team, I agree to comply with this policy and report any suspected abuse to the staff person who oversees the area in which I serve.
