



"And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts." 2 Peter 1:19

Day 0 – When Everything is Dark, The Holy Spirit is Near! (Presence Before Promise)

The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. Genesis 1:2

God gives you the Holy Spirit; now you must give yourself to the Holy Spirit.

Even if your darkness is getting deeper, with the Holy Spirit, your destiny is getting closer.

Day 1 – Light Without a Source (The Promise Without Evidence)

Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. Genesis 1:3

God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day. Genesis 1:5

Then God said, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; Genesis 1:14

So the evening and the morning were the fourth day. Genesis 1:19

Joseph's Day 1: Promise received: Joseph got the coat of many colors and dreams from God (Gen 37:3-9).

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1

Substance "hypostasis" - Foundation, assurance, confidence – something solid and real beneath something hoped for. A title deed, guarantee, or essence – a legal claim to what belongs to you, even if it's not yet seen.

Faith makes the invisible tangible before it becomes visible.

At first God's promise contradicts reality and then God's Spirit changes it.

Don't lower your promise to the level of your problem - that gap is room for God's power!

Day 2 – Separation (The Process of Purging)

Genesis 1:6-8 – God separated the waters from the waters.

God starts removing things from your life that don't align with His purpose. This is where people, positions, and things are taken away.

Joseph's Day 2: His coat was taken by his brothers (Gen 37:23). He was thrown into a pit and sold into slavery. He was separated from his father, his home, and his comfort.

God removes people to protect You.

God removes people to propel You into Your Purpose.



God removes people who No Longer Align with Your Journey.
God removes people because He is Planning to Bring Someone Else.

Day 3 – Formation (God is Developing You in the Dark)

Genesis 1:9-13 – Let the dry land appear... Let the earth bring forth grass... trees yielding fruit.

Once separated, God starts forming and developing you. Roots grow before fruit appears.

God doesn't just want you to have the promise—He wants you to have the character to sustain it.

Joseph's Day 3: His coat was removed again (Potiphar's wife took it – Gen 39:12). Joseph served in Potiphar's house and was falsely accused. In prison, his gifts of leadership and interpretation of dreams were developed (Gen 40).

Before you reign, you must be refined.

The pruning and pressing you experience today will produce the fruit of your tomorrow.

Until the time that his word came to pass, the word of the LORD tested him. Psalms 105:19

Your faith can't be trusted until it's tested.

A test reveals and refines. The word for "test" is more refiner's fire than classroom quiz. The test is less about passing and more about purging (1 Pet. 1:7; Prov 17:3; Zech 13:9; Ps 66:10)

Before God will do great work through you, He will do great work in you.

The great tragedy of an hour is when God's work through you exceeds God's work in you.

The desire of the young is to be discovered, whereas our greatest need is to be developed.

Day 4 – Fulfillment (The Word Comes to Pass!)

Now, what was light in the Spirit (Day 1) becomes structured (Day 4). Sun, moon, and stars are now visible signs of what God had already spoken. The Word is finally manifesting—your season of visibility is here!

Joseph's Day 4: From prison to the palace—his prophetic dream came to pass! (Gen 41:39-44).

What was spoken in obscurity was now visible to all!

God is not just fulfilling His Word—He is establishing you in a place of authority, influence, and purpose.

All things will work together for your good, even if those things themselves are not good right now.

But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive. Genesis 50:20

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. Romans 8:28
