



Luke 1:31–33 (NKJV)

“And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS.

He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.

And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.”

Main Points:

1. Dreams Are God’s Language to the Generations

- God speaks to us through dreams and visions that go beyond our lifetime.
- When one generation dreams, the next can walk in fulfillment.
- Like Mary, we must believe that what God conceives in us will bless others.

2. Don’t Abort the Dream — Nurture It

- Many believers allow doubt, fear, or failure to abort their God-given dreams.
- Within every believer lives two voices — the *dreamer* and the *doubter*.
- Keep faith alive even when circumstances seem impossible.

3. Dream Beyond Yourself — Through Your Sons and Daughters

- David dreamed of building God’s temple, but it was fulfilled through Solomon.
- Our calling is not just to achieve, but to prepare the way for the next generation.
- True legacy is when your children carry your dream further than you could.

4. Prayer Fuels the Dream

- Every breakthrough begins in prayer.
- Prayer creates a spiritual “magnet” that draws resources, people, and opportunities.
- Never underestimate how your prayers today will impact your children tomorrow.

5. God Is the God of Generations

- He is the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob — the same promise continues.
- What may seem dead or delayed can still live through your lineage.
- Your obedience today can become the foundation for generational blessing.
