

Time is not random. God is the Master of time, the God who sets seasons, orchestrates timing, and releases destiny at the appointed moment (Gen 1:14)

"My times are in Your hand." Psalm 31:15

"To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven." Ecclesiastes 3:1

God can stretch, compress, or restore time (Is 38:5-8; Joel 2:25)

"For the elect's sake, those days will be shortened." Matthew 24:22

1. Slow seasons are preparation for sudden breakthroughs.

Chronos (χρόνος) is sequential time, measured time or waiting time.

*Now Elizabeth's **full time** came for her to be delivered, and she brought forth a son. Luke 1:57*

Kairos (καιρός) is the right time, heaven's window or a divine opportunity.

*and saying, "**The time is fulfilled**, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:15*

*For the vision is yet for **an appointed time**; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry. Habakkuk 2:3*

*You will arise and have mercy on Zion; For the time to favor her, Yes, **the set time**, has come. Psalm 102:13*

*But behold, you will be mute and not able to speak until the day these things take place, because you did not believe my words which will be **fulfilled in their own time**." Luke 1:20*

***Until the time** that his word came to pass, the word of the LORD tested him. Psalm 105:19*

*A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation. I, the LORD, **will hasten it in its time**." Isaiah 60:22*

2. When you enter God's appointed time, He sends destiny helpers.

Destiny helpers arrive only when it's your time (Kairos) (Gen 41:9-14).

You must avoid destiny killers to access destiny helpers (Gen 39:7-12).

If you want destiny helpers, become one (1 Sa 30).

3. Your moment may show up wearing the face of a giant or the weight of a problem.

Kairos moments aren't convenient, but they're consequential; when it's your time, you can't afford to hesitate (Num 14:23)





When the moment comes, faith wears the costume of recklessness yet it's simply obedience to God's voice and confidence in His track record (Num 14:11, 22)

If you've witnessed God's power yesterday but speak defeat about tomorrow, that's spiritual amnesia—and it has consequences.

Attitudes spread. Fear is contagious. Faith is contagious. Choose what you're infecting others with.

4. The greatest kairos moment is the opportunity to accept Christ.

Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. Luke 19:41-42

and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation." Luke 19:44

For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, and in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation. 2 Corinthians 6:2

while it is said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion." Hebrews 3:15
